**Devyn Crerar:** “I play ball with the Warren Wildcats – 32 games this year!—and we won two gold medals!”

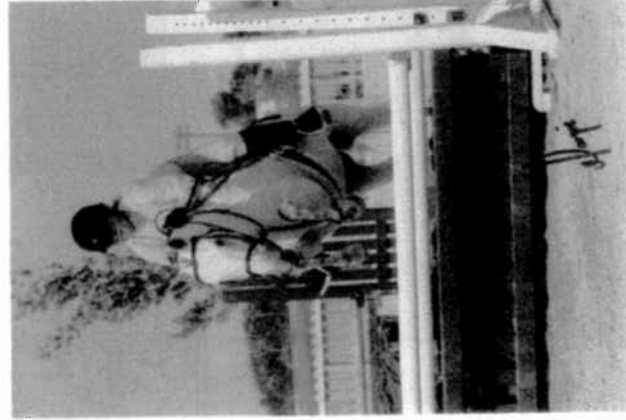


**Cassie Crerar:** “I practise my gymnastics because I’m part of the Selkirk Selects team – competitive gymnastics.”

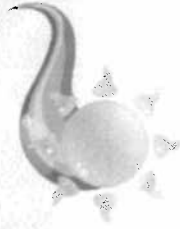


**Shane MacLennan:** “I’m learning to team-rope on my horse Spencer!”
